4-DAY CLASS—9:00 AM TO 4:00 PM—HAND & MACHINE

Little embroidered and appliquéd poodles prance around the hemline of this high waist dress. The poodle bodies are shadow stitched and embroidered with Floche embroidery cotton. Shadow work flowers adorn the yoke of the dress too. The pup's puffs are embellished with sprinkles of Colonial knots and little swirls of running stitches act as spacers between the shapes. Shadow work also adorns the bodice just above the skirt. The hem and armbands feature Madeira Appliqué and Point de Paris stitch by machine. You will learn the ins and outs of Madeira Appliqué, using the quick and easy method with Wendy's tried and true techniques. The armholes are uniquely treated with contrasting fabric binding, cut from the same black polka dot fabric as the hem and pin-stitched in place. The armbands are tied at the shoulders with bow ties. Double piping adorns the waistband in matching color combination to the embroidery design. The supplied pattern is included in sizes 2 to 8. This dress is made of imported baby lined pique.

4-DAY CLASS—9:00 AM TO 4:00 PM—HAND EMBROIDERY

During this 4-day lesson, you will learn the age-old techniques of Italian embroiderers. Based on an antique design, this reproduction baby dress features drawn thread hemstitching using various methods such as ladder stitch, hemstitch to join hems, woven bars, net darning and Reticella, an Italian drawn thread embroidery.

Beautiful swirls cascade along the front of the darling dress using Pisa cutwork techniques, a form of cutwork embroidery. Eyelets and padded satin stitch are featured in the design as well. Other details include joining lace to lace by hand and Pointe de Paris stitch.

The beautiful little dress is made of high quality white linen and beautiful French lace. The embroidery features pastel colors and traditional white embroidery, worked in stranded cotton thread. Hemstitched bars are enhanced with lovely lace stitch in contrasting color thread, carrying the pastel theme throughout the design.

You are sure to enjoy the leisurely days working on this magnificent creation. The included pattern is available in 12 month size but could easily be enlarged with Wendy's help based on the dimensions of the child. For extra large sizes, more linen may be necessary at a reasonable

additional cost.

Costs for La Broderie Bayou are for 4 Days of Classes. Your tuition includes kit, 4 lunches, snacks, iced tea and soda, bottled water, lessons, and presentations. Due to the limited number of spaces available, registrations will be filled on a first come, first served basis. Session One is limited to 15 attendees only. Session Two can accommodate a few more due to lack of sewing machine space.

There is a charge of \$450 due at time of Registration. This fee is non-refundable unless fulfilled by waiting list. If you are not able to attend, you must cancel in writing via email or otherwise. No one under 18 years of age is allowed to attend classes. Please note that knowledge of basic garment construction is required for this lesson of La Broderie Bayou. You will receive a registration confirmation via email.
