Don't worry; I'm not going to subject you to spicy foods, only to dazzle you with flavor! I promise you won't find better food anywhere else...well almost.



You will be required to bring a sewing machine in good working order. My experience on every machine model is invaluable. You must purchase your own supplies prior to arrival including threads, machine needles and everything else you might need. I do not have a full working shop any longer so my supplies are quite limited. I do have some fabrics and trims, many threads and some notions but definitely not everything you'll need. Complete Kits are included in the school fee.

The Vintage Baby Gown features sweet machine heirloom techniques such as tucks, hemstitch, lace insertion and gathering. In order to participate in this workshop, you must have a basic knowledge of construction sewing and can competently follow a pattern. The pattern is provided in one size and would make the perfect gift for any new arrival. Kits available in blue or white.

Kits include fabric, laces, trims, buttons, pattern, detailed instructions.

I am providing the pattern in assorted sizes, instructions, embroidery threads, hand needles, and all fabrics!. You must bring sewing thread, notions and basic sewing supplies. (See Pg. II for detailed supply list.

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Roses, Roses Key Fob or Pincushion



This beautiful heart-shaped key fob has many purposes. When used as a door knob decoration, pin cushion, or filled with lavender and used as a sachet, this silken treasure is sure to please. During this class, students will learn a few of the many ways roses can be stitched. There are beautiful rambling roses stitched as spoke flowers, sweet miniature roses stitched in groups of three, and of course, beautiful full roses stitched in full bloom bullion flowers. You will also learn Colonial Knots and Pick Stitch. This delightful selection of stitches are grouped together to form a most beautiful addition to your stitching repertoire.





IMPORTANT INFORMATION



TUITION

Class fees are \$719 for 5 day sessions, Monday-Friday 9:30 am to 4:00 pm. Studio closes at 5:00 pm daily. You may work on your own if you choose in studio until closing. Your 5-day Session includes patterns, one-on-one demonstrations and expert detailing. Sewing supplies are additional and mandatory. (See Supply List Page II).

KITS

Kits are included with class fee. Kits contain hand needles, embroidery floss, patterns and handouts. If you wish to make your project from a different fabric, please choose cotton with mini prints or solids, such as Liberty Tana.

REGISTRATION

Registration for each Session is immediate upon payment via my website (wendyschoen.com). If for any reason you decide to cancel your registration, you will receive a full refund minus \$50 registration fee, until June 15th. After then, you are required to purchase the kits. All fees are due at registration. We reserve the right to cancel at any time due to low registration. If cancellation is eminent, you will receive a full refund.

ENROLLMENT

Enrollment is open and spaces are limited. Because of this, classes will be filled on a first-come basis. After the session is filled, you will be put on a waiting list and notified if space comes available. Registration is open to adults at least 21 years of age with exceptions at the discretion of the instructor. Careful consideration and a desire to learn sewing is the prerequisite for participation. Our classroom is handicap accessible. Please let us know if you have special needs upon registration so we may accommodate you.

LUNCH

Lunch is included with the school fees. Meals are based on vummy home cooked meals. If you decide to go out for lunch, you probably should have transportation. If you are on a restricted diet, please let us know asap. We will try to accommodate you or have a substitute. I will be releasing a menu within the next few weeks.

CONSIDERATIONS

Please be prompt. Showing up late for class disrupts the rhythm of the lesson. However, some delays cannot be helped so if you arrive late, just take a seat and try to be patient until I catch you up.

PARKING

We are located in the Uptown Imports Building, 2923 Tchoupitoulas Street. We offer private off-street parking surrounding the building through the iron gates, accessible via Seventh Street. Please feel free to use our lot. Look for the baloons along the Uptown Imports Building at Tchoupitoulas and Seventh Streets.

SUPPLIES

Please bring your sewing machine in good working order plus all the feet you have. Basic sewing supplies include tape measure, pins, blue fabric markers, straight plastic ruler with 45 degree angle, scissors (paper, shears, and embroidery), extra bobbins, Lightweight cotton thread to match fabrics, #65, #70 and #100 machine needles, tearaway stabilizer, magnification, and extension choice. I have provided a complete supply list for your consideration on Page II.

ACCOMMODATIONS

We urge you to make your hotel reservation as soon as you book the class. I have chosen the following hotel for convenience and price. Hotel costs are <u>not</u> included in your tuition. I do not have a room block but rooms are available at a seasonally low rate, so act quickly! It's listed on Bookings.com along with other options.

Parking is free and the neighborhood provides new dining, shopping and entertainment options.

They do provide an airport shuttle for \$24/each way. Taxi service from the New Orleans Louis Armstrong Airport is approximately \$36 and approximately II miles from the hotel. If you need transportation to the studio, please call an Uber or United Cab (504) 434-5700.

WHAT'S IN THE KITS

Class kits include hand needles, embroidery threads, laces, entredeux, buttons, bees wax, hand-sewing thread, patterns and detailed instruction book. If purchasing additional kits, the prices are: Vintage Gown \$47, Roses \$24, and Slip & Romper \$58.50.

JUST IN CASE...
